



## United Nations Inter-Agency Games (IAG)

### IAG CREDENTIALS FORM

The governing body of the UN Inter-Agency Games, the Control Commission, recognizes participating organizations as per its General Rule 6<sup>1</sup>.

These participating organizations shall be represented through their officials. These officials shall be nominated by the participating organization's Staff Association/Union, Sports/Cultural/Staff Welfare Body or Human Resource Department which assumes responsibility of that organization's IAG participation.

The Control Commission recognizes the following official roles:

- *Control Commission Member*<sup>2</sup>
- *Focal Point*<sup>3</sup>
- *Registrar*<sup>4</sup>

A participating organization may nominate a titular and an alternate to each of these roles. More than one role may be held by a nominated person.
